Curbside recycling programs that accept many common recyclables are available for residents of some sections of Hatteras Island, Southern Shores, Duck, Kill Devil Hills, Kitty Hawk, and Nags Head. Please contact the town or your rental agent for more information. *

Plastics: # 2 bottles & jugs Translucent milk & water & tea jugs	Remove lids, rinse. Put into bins marked # 2 Plastics	Dare Public Works, Manteo Buxton Transfer Station & Recycling; Rodanthe; Kitty Hawk; Wanchese; Stumpy Point; Manns Harbor; Kill Devil Hills; Nags Head
Plastics: # 1 bottles soda & water, & juice	Remove lids, rinse. Put into bins marked # 1 Plastics	Same as above
All other Plastic Containers # 2 – # 7 bottles, hard plastic food containers No Styrofoam of any kind, buckets, plastic cups, plates, or toys.	Remove lids, rinse. Place into bins marked # 2 – # 7 Plastics	Dare Public Works, Manteo Buxton; Rodanthe; Kill Devil Hills; Wanchese; Stumpy Point; Manns Harbor;
Mixed paper Newspaper, office paper, mail, paperboard (shoeboxes, cereal boxes), magazines, catalogs, phone books, paper bags. No plastic bags, paper contaminated with food or dirt, waxed cartons, wet paper, pizza boxes.	Place in paper bags and put into mixed paper bin	Dare Public Works, Manteo Buxton; Rodanthe; Kitty Hawk; Wanchese; Stumpy Point; Manns Harbor; Kill Devil Hills; Nags Head
Aluminum cans – beverage only, no pet food cans	Place into bin marked aluminum cans.	Same as above
Steel cans – including pet food cans	Rinse, label may stay on. Place into steel cans bin	Same as above
Glass bottles, jars – curbside programs take only glass containers. The county sites can also take window glass and ceramics. No light bulbs, window frames	Rinse, remove lid. Curbside programs– bottles and jars only. No color separation necessary	Same as above
Cardboard corrugated cardboard only. No waxed, dirty, or wet boxes, pizza boxes	Preparation: keep dry, flatten. Place in cardboard bins	Same as above
Scrap metals and appliances stoves, washers, water heaters, air conditioners, refrigerators, pipe, siding, tools, lawn mowers, etc. No wire, wire fencing, crab pots, auto gas tanks or oil reservoirs	<u>Do not</u> crush appliances that contain Freon; drain all fluid reservoirs and tanks	Dare County Stumpy Point C & D Landfill, Buxton recycling center; Kitty Hawk; Kill Devil Hills, Nags Head
Cooking oil	Deliver in a bottle or jug	Dare Public Works, Manteo Kill Devil Hills
Antifreeze	<u>Do not</u> mix any other materials with antifreeze.	Dare Public Works, Manteo Kill Devil Hills and Nags Head
Used motor oil Including transmission fluid, diesel fuel, hydraulic fluid, and lubricating No Other hazardous materials.		Dare Public Works, Manteo Buxton; Rodanthe; Kill Devil Hills; Kitty Hawk

Vehicles Must be prepared and delivered to county	Remove and recycle all fluids	Dare County Stumpy Point C & D Landfill only
Used Oil Filters	Drain and recycle oil	Dare Public Works; Kill Devil Hills
Gasoline	Residential only	Dare Public Works; Kill Devil Hills
Tires	Must be off-rim. Kill Devil Hills residents max 4 tires	Dare Public Works, Manteo Buxton; Kill Devil Hills, Kitty Hawk
Lead-acid batteries	Bring to recycling center or take back to store or repair shop for rebate	Dare Public Works, Manteo Buxton; Kitty Hawk; Kill Devil Hills; Rodanthe
Oyster, Clam, & Mussel Shells	Collection cans available at some sites	Dare Public Works, Manteo Buxton; Kill Devil Hills
Electronics Computers, printers, phones, games, copy machines, radios, etc.	Usable items may be accepted at thrift shops	Dare Public Works, Manteo Buxton; Kitty Hawk, Nags Head, Kill Devil Hills, Rodanthe
Rechargeable Batteries	No single use batteries; Try to return to electronics or cell phone store	Kill Devil Hills; Kitty Hawk
Compact Fluorescent Bulbs	Some stores may take these back for recycling	Any residents S. of Rodanthe bring bulbs to Buxton or Rodanthe sites
Solid Waste Type	Disposal Instructions	Disposal Locations
Household Wastes	Must be bagged and put into carts	Call Town or County or look on the web site for pickup information. See below for information. *
Construction & demolition debris: furniture, lumber, siding, sheet rock, brick, etc. <u>No</u> asbestos, hazardous, or liquid wastes.	Must weigh load at scales and be prepared to pay for load	Buxton Transfer Station Dare County Stumpy Point C & D Landfill; Kill Devil Hills & Kitty Hawk: <i>Residents only</i>
Yard Waste: logs, limbs, leaves	Remove leaves from plastic bags or use paper leaf bags	Dare Public Works, Manteo Buxton Transfer Station Kill Devil Hills & Nags Head: <i>Residents only</i>
Bulky Waste Furniture, mattresses, box springs, and appliances	Call your town or county public works for information. Furniture and appliances can be put on the curb during large item pickups in the spring and fall, but no C & D is allowed. Usable items may be accepted at thrift shops.	The transfer stations in Stumpy Point or Buxton will take most of these items. Kill Devil Hills, Kitty Hawk, & Nags Head: <i>Residents only</i>
Paint and stain Latex only – Residentially generated only	Dry up and dispose or call Dare County Public Works for information	Dare Public Works, Manteo
Pesticides, herbicides, insecticides – must be in original containers.	Emergency disposal only	Must call Dare Public Works 475-4880 or NC Cooperative Extension Service 473-4290
